PROPOSALS:

1.) WINE:

2.) CRAFT BEER:

Visit any of the craft beer shops along Albert Road in Woodstock and purchase a pack of craft beer which again we would couple with an item of sporting memorabilia.

3.) SPORTING MEMORABILA:

Think about retired players and current players. I am approaching Corné Krige to sign his Technikon/Gardens No. 6 jersey of past history, Chippy Solomon, Stormers Manager, for a signed jersey, De Wet Barry, a signed Springbok jersey, etc.

We could purchase their jersey if they have not got one, or their socks, etc., and they then could sign the item, and again couple this with a wine or craft beer hamper/item, producing a valuable auction item.

<u>NOTE</u>: Do not wait until October. We have to start advertising the event now, and get prestige personalities to attend and let the rugby world know that there is a special event happening in October.
